

Driving in fog

Drive with headlights on low beam. It's illegal to drive with just parking or fog lights.

Reduce your speed.

Avoid crossing traffic unless absolutely necessary.

Listen for traffic that you can't see.

Use wipers and defroster if necessary.

Be patient. Don't pass lines of traffic.

Don't stop on any freeway or heavily traveled road unless absolutely necessary.

Move away from stalled or disabled cars to avoid injury.

Consider postponing trips until the fog clears.

Avoid the left lane — that's where you're likely to meet a wrong-way driver.

Leave early for work or call ahead to tell your employer you'll be a few minutes late.

Safe methods to exit a highway

When preparing to exit, look for raised lane-marker dots on the side of the road, which begin with three raised dots 2,100 feet from the exit.
